Please encourage your children to approach the test with a positive attitude and to do their best each day. During this testing schedule, please help your children to get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast. Make up testing due to absences is very difficult. For this reason, we ask that you avoid scheduling appointments and vacations during testing dates.
