QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or G.E.D.

- Demonstrate ability to operate and care for institutional kitchen equipment and ability to lift and carry objects up to 50 pounds.
- Demonstrate ability to communicate effectively in English, both orally and in writing.
- Always punctual, excellent attendance.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Open kitchen, turn on all ovens, warmers etc.
- Take temperatures of refrigerators and freezer and record.
- Fold laundry
- Prep and cook breakfast for both schools and clean up prep dishes
- Prep and cook lunch for both schools, main course, pizza, burgers and specialty items every day and on occasion dessert.
- Document all items in production records.
- Prep any necessary sack lunches and special diet meals.
- Plan for next day's meals and assemble, and document in production records.
- Replenish items between lines, sometimes includes cooking more food.
- Assist with dishes between first and second lunch and after third lunch.
- Clean tables after second lunch.
- Knock down cardboard and take to recycle.
