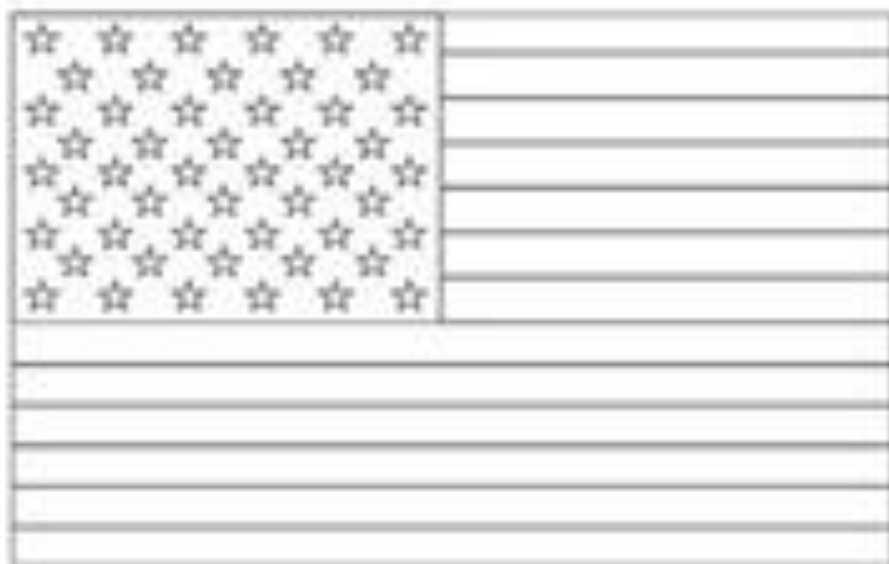

Stripes = Red and White



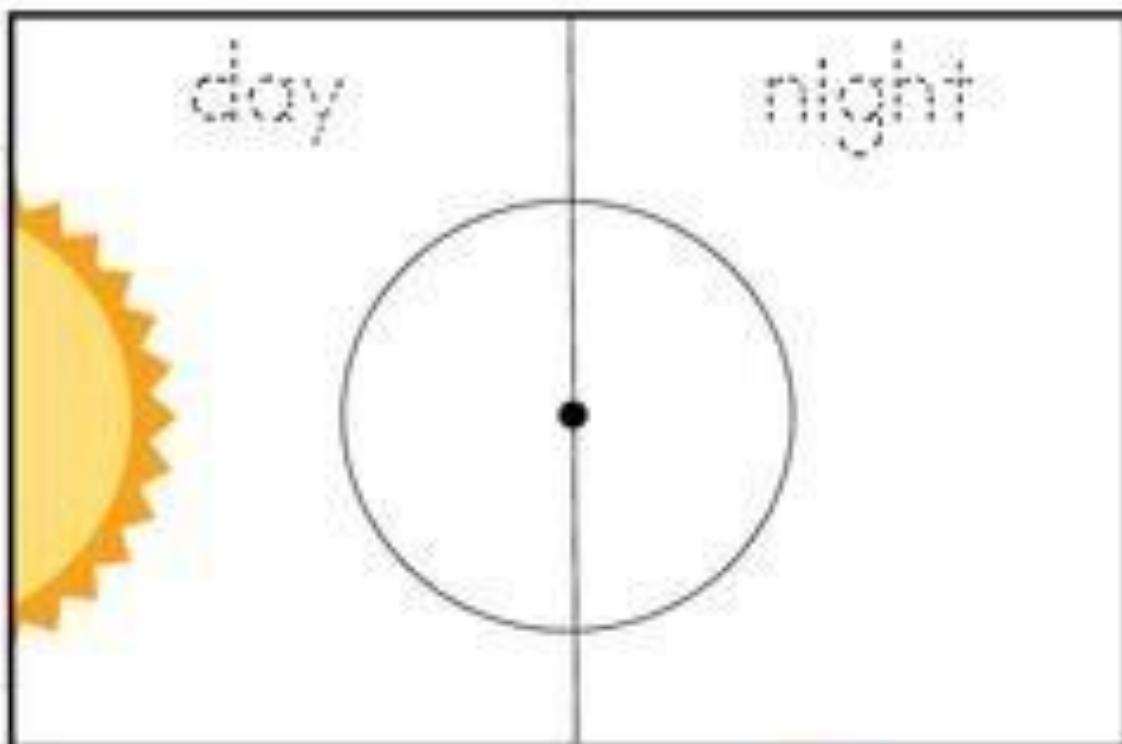

Why is There Day and Night?

The Earth **rotates** as it **orbits** the sun. This causes day and night!

rotate means to spin around.

orbit is the path the Earth takes as it goes around the sun.



Cut out the Earth and attach it to the circle with a brad so that the earth will rotate. Put an "X" where you live and watch as it moves through day and night as you spin "rotate" the Earth!
